

Dear Worldbuddy Activity # 1

One of the greatest things about being a Worldbuddy is becoming friends with someone in another country and getting to know each other. One way you can do this is to tell your buddy about yourself by writing a letter to them.

You can either write your own letter or use the letter outline to the right. All you need to do is:

1. Copy the details shown and fill in your details in the space provided.
2. In the space at the bottom write a message to your Worldbuddy and sign your name.
3. Include a photo(s) of yourself.

Get a grown-up to help you address the envelope. Use the World Vision address shown on the folder that has a picture of your Worldbuddy on it. And remember to write your sponsored **child's ID number and full name** on the back of the envelope.

DO NOT write your personal address details. This is to protect you if the letter gets into the wrong hands.
